The New Teacher Coaching Collaborative (NTCC) is a year-long, job-embedded dynamic coaching program supporting the unique needs of Texas' new teachers. The NTCC is aligned to the Texas Teacher Evaluation and Support System (T-TESS). Coaches focus on the four domains of the T-TESS as they guide the teacher's skill-building journey. New teachers also benefit from interactions in pairs or small groups, sharing experiences and reflections on their work. Large-group webinar events and five asynchronous individual learning modules round out the NTCC's robust resources for new teachers.
